Been wanting to write you all day, but here I am just getting around to it. And now it must be a V-mail one because the comms clerk I'll have to finish in a hurry if it's to go out cause we have no lights for night drings. Our tent is quite "homey" by now - we are fully equipped with a wooden frame, a piece for our bed rolls - so now we can afford to be snooty with the ants. When we live with them on the ground we sorta fondle them - but now that we are elevated above them - physically at least - we resort to molesting them again! - My mail is starting to come around by degrees - tho' haven't had a letter for almost a week now. But I'm lucky at that. Some of the fellows still have their first to get that which I have about 8 or nine. That's what they get for not having a sister like mine! - I've even gotten a V-mail dated May 3rd, - and, boy, - believe me when I say that's really fresh news! Have run into some more boys from Avon who tell me Joe Hollinger is grounded - something to do with his depth perception. Hope luck! - I'll try to write a regular letter, maybe tomorrow. Don't ask me why, tho' - for goodness sake I have nothing more to really add!
